Avoid Legal Exposure

- Failure to comply with Section 508 of the Department of Justice's ADA (American with Disabilities Act) Standards for Accessible Design could expose your company to hefty fines, the risk of expensive criminal and civil litigation as well as a reputation for being unfriendly to the disabled.
- Websites who do not meet WCAG 2.1 AA accessibility standards can be fined up to \$50,000 for a first violation and \$100,000 for a second, and even more for compensation of damages.



Easy Website Integration - (usually less than 10 minutes)

- Simple 10 step process that consists of:
 - Enter your website address – will detect the platform
 - Icon choice
 - Size of Icon
 - Color
 - Location on pages
 - Language (defaults to autodetect browser user's language)
 - Existing accessibility statement
 - Branding interest (can brand with your Logo for \$10 a month)
 - Instant code to paste in your website
 - Tests and confirms the widget is working properly!
